ABOUT MRCG The Media Reform Coordinating Group (MRCG) is the coordinating Secretariat for media reform, research and capacity building. It comprises Sierra Leone Association of Journalists (SLAJ), Independent Radio Network (IRN), Guild of Editors (GoE), Women in the Media Sierra Leone (WIMSAL), Sierra Leone Reporters Union (SLRU), Sport Writers Association of Sierra Leone (SWASAL), Faculty of Communication, Media and Information Studies (Fourah Bay College), Ministry of Information and Civic Education (MoICE), Independent Media Commission (IMC) and the Sierra Leone Broadcasting Corporation (SLBC).

1. INTRODUCTION

The Media Reform Coordinating Group (MRCG) continued the monitoring of the electoral processes leading to the June 2023 elections in Sierra Leone. It could be recalled that, during the voter registration phases, the MRCG did a comprehensive report of how the media covered the registration exercise; the challenges faced, and proffered recommendations for Election Management Bodies to work with journalists and media houses so that real time information could be communicated to the public.

The Electoral Commission Sierra Leone (ECSL) continued implementing activities according to its schedule. In the months of April and May, ECSL commenced the distribution of voter ID cards to voters across the country and the nomination of candidates for the various elections. As per the first published timeline of the electoral activities for external stakeholders, the distribution was supposed to have commenced from 17 to 26 March 2023. However, in a press release dated 13 March 2023, the ECSL rescheduled the distribution to commence from 7 to 16 April 2023.

The media continued to monitor and report on the electoral activities, including the distribution of voter ID cards and nomination of candidates for the Paramount Chiefs Member of Parliament Election (PCMP). The ECSL in a press release dated 7 April 2023 announced the collection of voters ID cards in all 3, 630 registration centers across the country. The process which lasted for a period of 10 days, had successes and challenges which the media reported on.

In a press release dated 17 April, 2023, the ECSL announced that 2,613,655 voters across the country had collected their voters ID which represented 77% of the total number of registered voters. The release also mentioned that a total of 5, 205 ID cards were without photos or photo less registrants, 502 cards were mismatched and 9,061 were misplaced.

According to the ECSL timeline, the period 30 March to 1 April 2023 was slated for the nomination of PCMP in all 14 districts. In a press release dated 17 April 2023, ECSL announced the declaration of uncontested PCMP duly elected as PCMP in Sierra Leone. Among the fourteen (14) districts, seven (7) districts had uncontested PCs; Kailahun, Kono, Tonkolili, Karene, Port Loko, Bo and Moyamba. The ECSL on 20 May 2023, as per election timeline conducted the PCMP election for the other seven (7) districts. However, as at the time of producing this report results for the other 7 districts were yet to be announced.

The nomination of candidates for the various elections for councillors, members of parliament (MP), mayoral candidates, and presidential candidates commenced on the 19 April to the 9 May 2023. For each of the said elections, ECSL requested the various political parties to submit list of their approved candidates that they had internally agreed on.

This report presents the role played by the media in the distribution of voters ID cards and nomination process of PCMP, councillors, members of parliament (MP), mayoral candidates, and presidential candidates; it highlights impacts and challenges of the two electoral activities and presents recommendations to the necessary authorities.

2. METHODOLOGY AND RESULTS

The MRCG monitored two radio stations, one TV station and newspapers that are published on a daily basis. From the findings, all of the media houses discussed or reported issues related to the electoral process of card distribution and nomination process for over a period of one month.

The MRCG from 7 April to 17 May 2023 monitored the SLBC Radio and TV, Radio Democracy, and newspapers publications that had discussions or publications on issues with regards to the electoral activities monitored.

SLBC

SLBC radio during their morning program 'Morning Coffee' on 12, 17, 19 and 20 April 2023 hosted officials from ECSL who spoke about the voter ID cards distribution and responded to concerns from the public regarding the quality of the ID cards and the distribution process. From a vox pop that was done by the said radio station from the public, there were mixed feelings regarding the public opinion with regards the quality of the cards. However, ECSL officials during their media engagements allayed the fears of the public over the quality and tried to persuade them to focus on the special security features of the said ID cards.

Also for the nomination process of the various elections, the SLBC in their 'Morning Coffee' programs on the 2, 3, 8 and 9 of May hosted senior officers of ECSL and PPRC to discuss issues relating to the nomination process. Their discussions were around the process of nominations, the role of the eligible political parties in the nomination, the management of the process and the challenges faced by ECSL in conducting the nominations, the experience of political parties during the nomination process and the observation of the nomination process by PPRC among others.

The Print Media (Newspaper Publication)

The print media was monitored on a daily basis by monitors of the MRCG and took note of headlines and sources that are related to the electoral processes. Like the broadcast media, the print media on a daily basis published concerns over the process of card distribution, the quality of the cards, low turnout of voters to collect cards, the nomination process, work of EMBs and cries of political parties.
